Rob,

I have a copy of your fax to Jay Godfrey dated December 15, 1997, and I reference your voice mail to me of approximately the same time. To the extent you are doing research specifically for materials being prepared for Mr. Lay or Enron, we would be happy to assist you. To the extent you are working on materials that are to be used for any outside interest you might have, for example the Cato Institute, I would appreciate it if you would clearly so inform us.

Finally, you mentioned in your voice mail to me that you had been invited to provide input to some people at the DOE's Energy Information Agency regarding the cost of wind power. I would appreciate it if you would refer those individuals to us, as I think we are in the best position to discuss the cost of wind power with them on behalf of Enron. We are particularly sensitive to how the cost of wind power is portrayed, and particularly to the Energy Information Agency as its data is often used as a key input to the development of government policy towards renewables.
